Career Opportunity - Senior Machine Operator

The Senior Machine Operator has the responsibility for operating equipment including a plow truck, backhoe, and grader for the safe removal of snow and for maintenance of the roads. The Senior Machine Operator is required to be on call and will work extended hours as required under the direction of the Road Superintendent.

Qualifications:

- Completion of Grade 12 or equivalent;
- Three years of related experience, preferably in a municipal environment;
- Knowledge and experience of road maintenance and construction and operation of related equipment including plow truck with wing and sander, grader, backhoe, steam jenny, and general shop tools would be an asset;
- Valid DZ License with clean driver abstract;
- Certified chainsaw safety and operator;
- Ability to work independently and collaboratively as a member of a team;
- Excellent organizational, time management, communication, and interpersonal skills; and
- Living within the community is considered an asset.


