

**THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF LAIRD**

**By-law Number 2020-24**

Being a By-law providing for the erection of a stop sign at an intersection.

**WHEREAS** Section 137 (a) of *The Highway Traffic Act* (R.S.O. 1990, Chapter H8) provides that the Council of a municipality may by By-Law provide for the erection of stop signs at intersections on highways under its jurisdiction and every sign so erected shall comply with the regulations of the Ministry of Transportation;

**NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF LAIRD ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. The intersection of the Highways set out in Column 1 are designated as an intersection where a stop sign shall be erected at the location shown in Column 2 to replace an existing yield sign.

**Column 1  
Intersection**

**Column 2  
Facing Traffic**

Neebish Road West  
and Finns' Bay Road North

Northbound on Finns' Bay North

2. The penalties provided in Section 214 of *The Highway Traffic Act* shall apply to offenses against this By-Law.
3. That every sign so erected shall comply with the regulations of the Ministry of Transportation.
