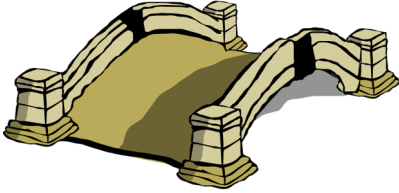

Government Road Bridge - Bridge Closure for Upcoming Repairs



The Government Road Bridge located 650 meters south of Bar River Road will be undergoing extensive repairs. The contractor is to begin repairs mid-August, during the repairs the bridge will be closed for approximately 2 weeks. Please keep an eye out for bridge closure signage.

Community Safety Zones:

The Laird Township Council has received many complaints concerning speeding in three areas of the municipality and is considering establishing Community Safety Zones in the Laird Township. Section 214.1 (1) of The Highway Traffic Act states that the Council of a municipality may by By-law designate a part of a highway under its jurisdiction as a community safety zone if, in the Council's opinion, public safety is of special concern on that part of the highway. Therefore, Council would like the public's feedback on the three areas of the Township, which comprises five sections of road.

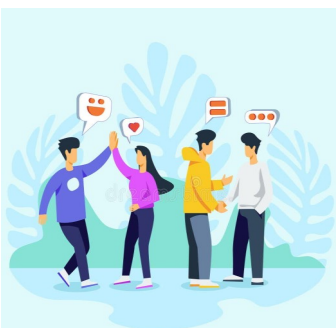
